Checklist: Breeding Approval (Stallions)

Stallion: _____ FSA Reg. #: _____

All stallions must meet the following criteria to be **Approved for Breeding** or **Provisionally Approved for Breeding**:

- DNA Testing** -- photocopy of DNA report
- Minimum 3-generation pedigree
- Stallion is registered in the Main Book Foundation Book or Auxiliary Book

Additionally, stallions must meet the following criteria (include documentation (photocopies of results, etc.)):

Provisional Breeding Approval:

To be provisionally Approved for Breeding, stallions must meet the criteria for *either* Option 1 or Option 2:

Option 1 - stallion must have met the following criteria:

- Inspection* or in-hand* score of 72% or higher
- Fulfilled the requirements for the BRONZE ELITE BOOK for either Dressage, Combined Driving, or Eventing.

Option 2 - stallion must have met the following criteria:

- Fulfilled the requirements for the SILVER or GOLD ELITE BOOK

Approved for Breeding:

To be fully Approved for Breeding, stallions must meet the criteria for *either* Option 1 or Option 2:

Option 1 - stallion must have met both of the following criteria:

- Inspection* or in-hand* score of 72% or higher
- Fulfilled the requirements for the SILVER or GOLD ELITE BOOK

Option 2 - Stallions which pass the FPZV stallion testing, or are approved with any WBFSH recognized registry, will be automatically eligible to be Approved for Breeding.

- Stallion has been approved for breeding with the FPZV or a WBFSH recognized registry (registry: _____ (include documentation))

**Inspection and in-hand scores: In-hand scores must be earned at USEF recognized competitions or USDF DSHB classes. Inspection scores must be from breed registry inspections from registries which are members of the WBFSH, FHANA or FPZV inspections.*
