- All Friesian Sporthorses must be registered with the FSA (Friesian Sporthorse Association) in order to be inspected.
- Please submit all registration paperwork (or a copy of the horse's Registration Certificate) and payment along with this Inspection Entry Form to the FSA (Friesian Sporthorse Association, PO Box 283, Seville, FL 32190)
- **Inspection Entry must be postmarked four weeks prior to inspection date (or earlier) to avoid a late fee of \$50.**
- Contact the inspection host / organizer directly for information about stabling, facility requirements, availability of handlers, etc.
